



Authorizing ArcGIS Pro Concurrent Use licenses offline

Open your ArcGIS License Server Administrator, navigate to the Authorization folder and select ArcGIS Pro 1.4 - 2.6 from the drop-down menu


Click Authorize Now



Under Authorization Options, select I need to authorize licenses on my license server



When prompted for an authorization method select Authorize at Esri's website or by email to receive your authorization file and click Next




Complete the required authorization information on the following pages and click Next






Fill in the authorization codes and the number of licenses being authorized and click Next




If you have extensions, select I have authorization numbers(s) to authorize one or more extensions and insert the authorization number and number of licenses in the table and click Next




An authorize.txt file will be generated.

Save the file to a location of your choice




On a device connected to the Internet, log in to My Esri with an account that has Licensing Permissions.

Navigate to My Organization > Additional Licensing Forms > Secure Site Operations




Using the Choose File button, browse to the authorize.txt file you created and click Upload




Your authorize.txt file will be converted into a secure license file which will automatically download on your device and appear on the bottom left-hand corner of your browser

Click on the file and allow it to run and make changes to your machine when prompted



You will be returned to the software authorization screen and your file automatically referenced

Click Next to proceed



You will be notified when the authorization is complete with a list of authorized features

Click Finish to close the wizard
